C17.38 Minutes of the previous meeting

The committee received the minutes of the meeting on 26 September 2017 and affirmed them as a true record.

C17.39 Music Festival

The committee considered the annual reoccurrence for this request and noted that the total funding required was not included. There was some discussion about the remaining funds in the budget and a number of councillors suggested that how reoccurring grants are represented in the budget could be considered at the subsequent meeting. The committee established that the request comprised of three £50 prizes and the cost of medals for each category participating.

There was a discussion about the budget limit and who would be attending. It was confirmed that the costs would not exceed the £3000 within the Big Lunch budget.

Resolved: To host a Christmas themed memory café in the Carnegie theatre in association with Workington Dementia Action Alliance, using funds from the Big Lunch budget.
