The large scale demolition, construction and final development would cause a significant impact to the access and traffic flow on the street. In addition, the allocated parking provision provided is insufficient in relation to the size of the development. With consideration of other developments and properties in the immediate area, the amount of units proposed would result in an overdevelopment in this section of the town. On these grounds the committee recommend refusal
